Mr. Jermaine V. Fleming earned a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University in Tallahassee Florida and a Masters Degree in Educational Leadership from Nova University in Ft. Lauderdale Florida. In the Fall of 2006, Mr. Fleming will earn a Doctorate of Education in Educational Leadership from Nova University.

As a member of the "World Renowned" FAMU's Marching 100, Mr. Fleming has performed locally and abroad. Most notably, he performed with "The 100" in Paris, France for the Bastille Day Celebration, the 1992 Inaugural Parade for President William Jefferson Clinton and at numerous professional and college football half-time performances.

Mr. Fleming is the former Director of Bands at Miami Jackson High School and New Renaissance Middles School (Miramar, FL).
